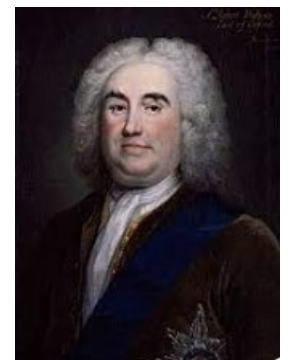
I can understand how the Monarchs have changed over time and how certain events in time have influenced their power. I can identify reasons why this happened and suggest the impact that this had on Britain.
