Dear Parents and Carers,

I hope that you had a restful break over Easter and managed to enjoy some sunshine in between the showers! We are looking forward to a busy final term in Year 3!

The daily routine will remain the same, the children will arrive at the gate between 08:45 and 08:55 before taking part in English, maths, guided reading and spelling lessons in the morning. Other curriculum subjects will be taught in the afternoon. All subject overview pages for Geography, Science, RE, Music, PSHE, Art and Computing are available on the website. After half term we will rotate to History, Spanish and D&T.

Our PE days this half term will continue to be **Wednesday** and **Friday**. The children should wear black jogging bottoms or shorts, white t-shirts and their navy blue PE hoodie. They can continue to wear black trainers everyday as we are regularly active. The children should be wearing their full uniform on non-PE days. The children should bring their **bookbags** to school everyday and these are stored in their trays. Message books and super star reading records should also be in school everyday. Messages regarding any issues in school will be sent home in message books with all other communication going through admin.

In **English**, we will be studying adventure narratives, followed by the texts of *The Big Book of Blooms*, *The Day the Crayons Quit*, *The Paperbag Prince* and a poetry sequence around *The Works and Paint me a Poem*.

In **Maths**, we will be learning about Mass & Capacity, Shape, Time and Statistics before consolidating our prior learning.

Our Around the World challenge and spelling tests will both continue to be on a Friday. Spellings for the half term will be sent home. The children should continue reading at home regularly as this has a huge impact on their progress with reading.

Thank you for your continuing support with fundraising, trips and events. As ever, we have lots planned for this term and we are excited to make the most of the (hopefully!) warmer weather!
