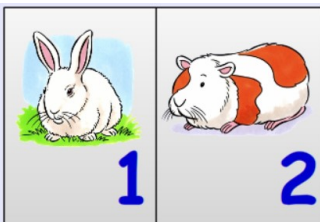


### Key Vocabulary

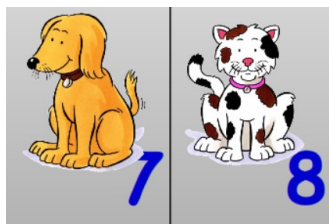
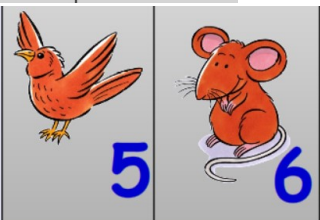
