How we intend to spend the grant

At Winkleigh Primary School we have:-

- Purchased licences for Physical fitness online sessions to support pupils well-being (Jump start Johnny)
- Invested in a HLTA / teacher (5 days a week) to support individual and groups of children with gaps identified in their reading knowledge, as this was identified in the SIP as a key area and data showed that all classes had individual children who had significantly slipped with their reading

How the effect of this expenditure on the educational attainment of these pupils at the school will be assessed?

At Winkleigh Primary school we assess the effect of this spending by:

- On going teacher assessment
- ½ termly review of impact feeding into School Improvement Plan
- Data showing that children are back to where they were in the Spring 2020 data or exceeding
