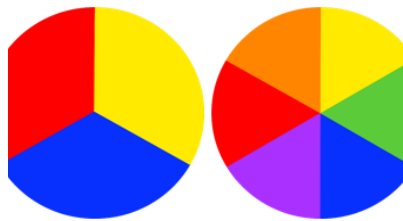


ART— Mixed Media Textiles
