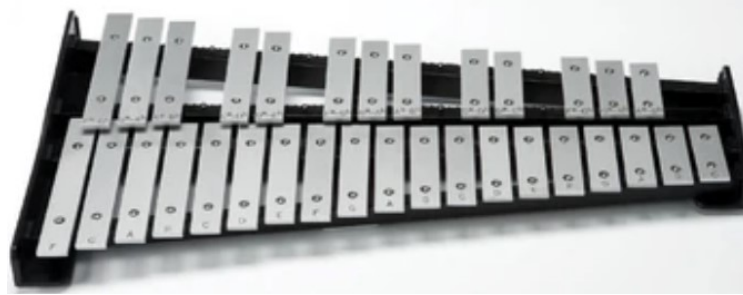


Glockenspiel Stage 2
