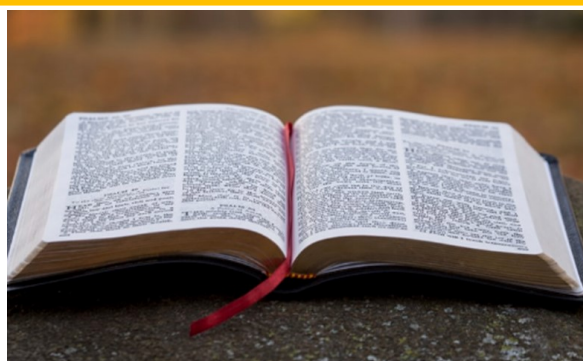


# RE- What is the 'good news' Christians believe Jesus brings?

## Legacy

### Prior Knowledge:

The children know that Christians believe in God, why He is important to them and what they believe God is like. They have read, heard and discussed bible stories and visited the local church. They have also learnt about who Christians say made the world. The children have learnt about why Easter is important to Christians.
