## **Class 2 Exeter Educational Visit – Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November**

We have arranged for Class 2 to visit Exeter on Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> November. We have the excellent experience of visiting Pizza Express and taking part in their workshop for schools that will enable the children to design and make, and then eat, their own pizza for lunch. After our Pizza Express workshop, we will walk to the Royal Albert Memorial Museum and spend time exploring the exhibits for a future History sequence.

### Transport

We will travel to Exeter by train from Eggesford station, leaving on the 09:01 train. We would be grateful if you would drop your child to the station. Children need to be at the station by 8.50am at the latest. Staff will be available there from 8.30am to enable you to drop any siblings to school. Using the train is far cheaper than travelling by coach and allows us to offer the children the fantastic experience of travelling by train.

We will return to Eggesford at 14:57, enabling time to return to school to collect any siblings. Children will be dismissed from the platform once we have matched adults to children! We greatly appreciate your support with transport to enable the children to have this brilliant experience. In the past, parents have organised car shares amongst themselves, school is unable to do this on your behalf. Please let us know if someone else is collecting/dropping your child for safeguarding reasons.

### Lunch

As mentioned above, we have booked Pizza Express where the children will design and make, and then eat, their own lunch, followed by dessert.

### Other information

The children will need to wear school uniform as normal with their school jumper, to enable us to identify them easily. They may also need a coat, they may bring a rucksack for this visit. Each child will need to bring a drink. Lunch is provided, which will be the pizza that they make followed by dessert.

### Cost

The price of the visit will be £7.50 per child. This trip has been carefully costed to ensure that we are offering the best experience at the best price. We have subsidised this visit with funds kindly donated by FOKNS, however, there are no additional funds available to subsidise this trip further so we do rely on payment for each child.
