

A note from the Head

Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been so lovely to welcome back all the children this week, they have returned with smiles and enthusiasm. Throughout the school we have welcomed 10 new children as well as 19 in our Owls class, they have all settled really well and the children have made them feel very welcome.

I have been visiting classes throughout the week and have been very impressed with the children's learning attitude, they have been focused and keen to demonstrate a positive learning attitude.

We also welcome two new teaching assistants this term, Mrs Evans and Mrs Hooper who are based in Key Stage 1. It's like they have always been here!

I am pleased to reassure you that our building does not contain any Reinforced Autoclaved Aerated Concrete (RAAC) so we will not have to temporarily close any part of our building, which is good news.

There were a lot of external works carried out over the summer. The driveway and pavement have been re-tarmacked, this was funded by Devon County Council and not from school budget, we are very grateful for this as it has made the area much safer. We have had new hall doors installed as our old ones were on their last legs! Three classrooms have had new LED lights installed. Both the lights and the doors installations have been funded by the Government's Energy Efficiency Grant.

We have also had the front doors and railings painted blue, which I think really brightens up the whole front entrance.

Please can we ask that Owls Class Parents wait at the bottom of the steps at the end of the day when collecting your children. It is sometimes difficult for them to see who is picking them up when there are a lot of adults standing around.

Can we also ask that if your child goes home on the school bus, you inform the office via a phone call or email should your child NOT be on the bus for some reason to avoid any confusion. This is also the same for pick ups from the gate. If your child is being collected by a different adult to usual, please ensure you let us know via email or in their communication book where applicable. This saves unnecessary worry for your child. Thank you.

It has been lovely to see the sunshine back, I think we all could have predicted as soon as the children returned to school, the weather would change! Hopefully it will stay for the weekend.

Should I keep my child off school?

Yes

Until...

Chickenpox	at least 5 days from the onset of the rash and until all blisters have crusted over
Diarrhoea and Vomiting	48 hours after their last episode
Cold and Flu-like illness (including COVID-19)	they no longer have a high temperature and feel well enough to attend. Follow the national guidance if they've tested positive for COVID-19.
Impetigo	their sores have crusted and healed, or 48 hours after they started antibiotics
Measles	4 days after the rash first appeared
Mumps	5 days after the swelling started
Scabies	they've had their first treatment
Scarlet Fever	24 hours after they started taking antibiotics
Whooping Cough	48 hours after they started taking antibiotics

but make sure you let their school or nursery know about...

Hand, foot and mouth	Glandular fever
Head lice	Tonsillitis
Threadworms	Slapped cheek

Are you entitled?

Families with children in Key Stage 1 who are eligible are encouraged to apply as the funding is in addition to Universal Infant Free School Meals!

If your circumstances have changed and you are now in receipt of one or more of the following:

- Universal credit (provided you have a net income of £7400 or less)
- Income support
- Income-based jobseekers' allowance
- Income-related employment and support allowance
- Support under Part IV of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
- The guaranteed element of state pension credit
- Child tax credit, provided that you are not also entitled to working tax credit and have an annual gross income of £16,190 or less

You may be eligible for pupil premium funding for Winkleigh Primary School, which entitles your child/ren to receive Free School Meals.

It takes less than a minute to apply.
