My Composite Knowledge:

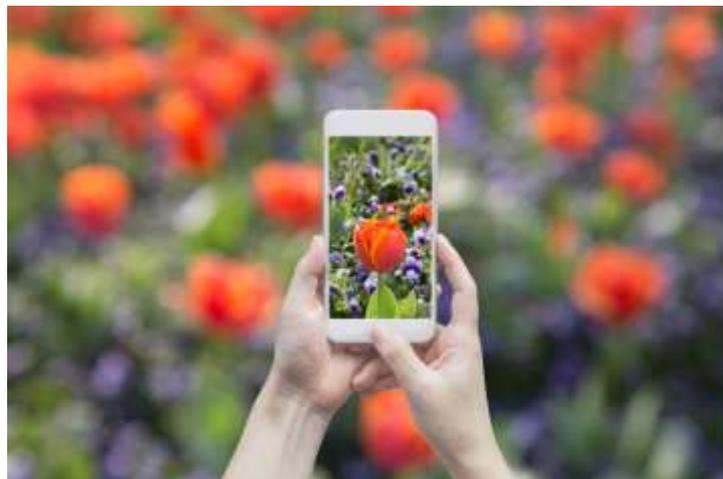
I can learn about how photos were taken in the past and whether that is similar or different to nowadays.
