

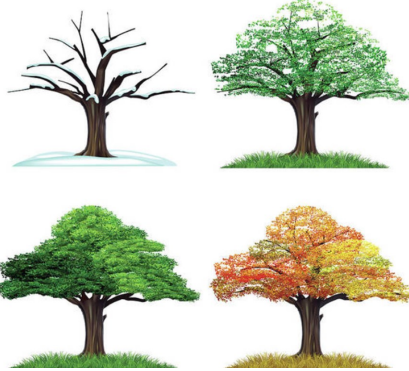
Seasonal Changes

I can make observations of environment and weather. I can use my previous experience from last year and apply scientific vocabulary and understanding to what I know.

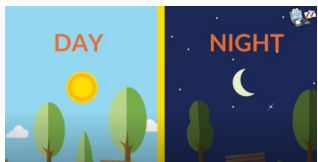
